Stony Brook Lemonade Stand Serves Up \$1K to SB Children's Hospital

A group of Stony Brook kids squeezed over \$1,000 in lemonade sales, selling more than 500 cups of the tart stuff, to donate to Stony Brook Children's Hospital.

It was the second time the kids of Spencer Lane in Stony Brook's S-Section, got together to man the stand, decorated with colorful yellow flags, and nearly doubled last year's take.

"The kids wanted to do something to help other kids, and they thought a great summer activity that can be enjoyed by many was a lemonade stand," said Laura Mastriano, mom of Maddie, 14, and Joseph, 10, who helped out in the sale. Last year in a period of two hours, the kids raised \$640 on their own."
